

The Seminar was inaugurated by the Principal Secretary Animal Husbandry, Jammu & Kashmir, Shri Dr. Asgo Hassan Sanoon Govt. The Inaugural ceremony was joined by the Dr. Anis Ansari, Chairman, Centre for Agriculture and Rural Development, Prof. Najeer Ahmed, VC, SKUAST, Ms. Poornima Mittal, Director Animal Husbandry, Mrs. Kamna Barkataki, Director, Central Poultry Development Organization, Chandigarh.

The Seminar was aimed to promote Poultry sector in Kashmir by inviting experts from Industry, Research Institutions, Bankers, Govt. officials. Government of Kashmir is very keen to develop Kashmir as emerging market and to become a major player in Poultry sector. Though, despite having all kinds of requisite environmental conditions, the state has not emerged as compare to other states. But, over the last five years, Kashmir has gained momentum.





Dr.T.Kotiah, Managing Director, Indbro

The program begun with Technical session and Dr. T.Kotiah was the first speaker. He said that popularity of chicken meat is growing so rapidly that in a very short span, it will overtake pork, mutton and all other forms of non-vegetarian diet. He focused on small scale rural poultry including kuroiler chicken, which can generate huge self employment in rural areas. He said that in coming years, Kashmir would emerge as a Poultry Hub and such kind seminar should be organize at regular intervals. On backyard and rural poultry he has given a presentation.



Dr. Anis Ansari (Chairman-CARD) welcomed all the guests and said that the Jammu & Kashmir Govt has given impetus to the Agriculture sector. He said Kashmir is a large market owing to its voluminous population. He said as the cold chain is quite weak, we intend to organize it and make it more efficient in future.

Ms. Poornima Mittal, KAS, Director, Department of Animal Husbandry, Kashmir “it is a pleasure that an institution like CARD has organized today's seminar and expo to sensitize all the stakeholders of this important sector of poultry development in



Kashmir valley. As a Director of Animal Husbandary, I would like to give the status of the poultry in Kashmir valley. Poultry I think plays a very key role in many households in improving the socio-economic status. It makes a substantial contribution to poverty elevation, food security, empowerment of women, and mainly the employment generation. Poultry and poultry products are an important component of the human diet in most of the developing countries of the world including Kashmir valley. The consumption of poultry is also increasing at a rapid rate due to low-fat content, easy availability, and cost-effectiveness. Poultry meat is the least cost alternative next to fish which produces animal protein It requires less area and offers high returns than any other animal husbandry and



agriculture activity.

Dr. Kamna Barkataki, Director, Central Poultry Development Organization, Chandigarh it is a great honor for me that I am present here today on a very exciting occasion and delighted to address such a talented gathering.

CPDO Central Poultry Development Organisation it was a first organization called as government poultry firm in 1963. In that time it was under the Punjab government, then in 1966, it was a poultry project

under UT Chandigarh. Then there was Centre Poultry Breeding Firm came under the government of India in 1978. Finally, in 2003, it was called a Central Poultry Development Organisation from Government of India.

Our role in improvising poultry farmers is firstly by production and distribution of superior low input technologies and chicks to state poultry organizations and farmers under rural poultry development. We also provide skill development training to the women and farmers of the northern state. Training duration is 6 days that are especially for unemployed youth, women, and farmers that is totally free of cost and with the end of the training, we give them certificates. New technologies and approaches should be adopted to transform the unorganized poultry system into a successful venture. This poultry seminar and expo has taken our state to a very positive stage. I would like to conclude by thanking organizations for taking a huge step and also giving me an opportunity to be a part of it.

Prof. Najeer Ahmed, VC-SKUAST, Srinagar

On behalf of the University, I welcome you all to Kashmir Poultry Seminar and Expo 2019,

As we all know India is mainly an agriculture country, supports almost 65% of the population and it is also contributing 14% to the GDP. The poultry industries are worth around 1.75 lac crore, in that 80 thousand crores is from the chicken side and almost 90 thousand crores are coming from the eggs but again in this sector, I think the commercial sector is contributing almost 80%. The egg production we have reached to 88 billion from 66 billion in 2011 to 2016-17 But the per capita availability of the eggs are also has increased but the requirement is of 188 eggs and we have huge

potential for the egg production not only in our country but for our states to. And almost the same scenario is



with poultry meat.

Dr. Asgar Hassan Samoon, Principal Secretary, Animal Husbandry, Jammu & Kashmir Dr. Samoon congratulated CARD for organizing such a great event very first time in the Kashmir valley. He also expressed his gratitude to the SKUAST, participating organizations, farmers, experts, scientists for joining the poultry expo. Further, he said poultry has immense potential in India despite having to have regional imbalances in the growth and development. Southern states especially Andhra Pradesh has made remarkable progress.

Kashmir is one of the largest importers of eggs, broiler in India, despite having requisite climatic conditions to be self-reliance in production and marketing. Currently, we are producing 75,000 metric tons of broiler meat. 12,500 metric ton poultry meat, 5.71 crores the old chicks, 75,000 metric ton feed, and 95 crores eggs we had imported last year.

Department of Animal Husbandry inviting feed industries to set up poultry feed manufacturing plants in Kashmir. Chick providing companies to set up hatcheries units, companies who are manufacturing drinker, feeder, heating equipment to set up manufacturing plants here in Kashmir. We have roped in the industry department and about to launch a policy for setting as poultry state. Where we are planning to provide land to the industry for manufacturing plants. A large number of agriculture graduates can come and take up the self-employment opportunity for setting up broiler layer farms. The huge potential for setting up poultry processing plants in Kashmir.

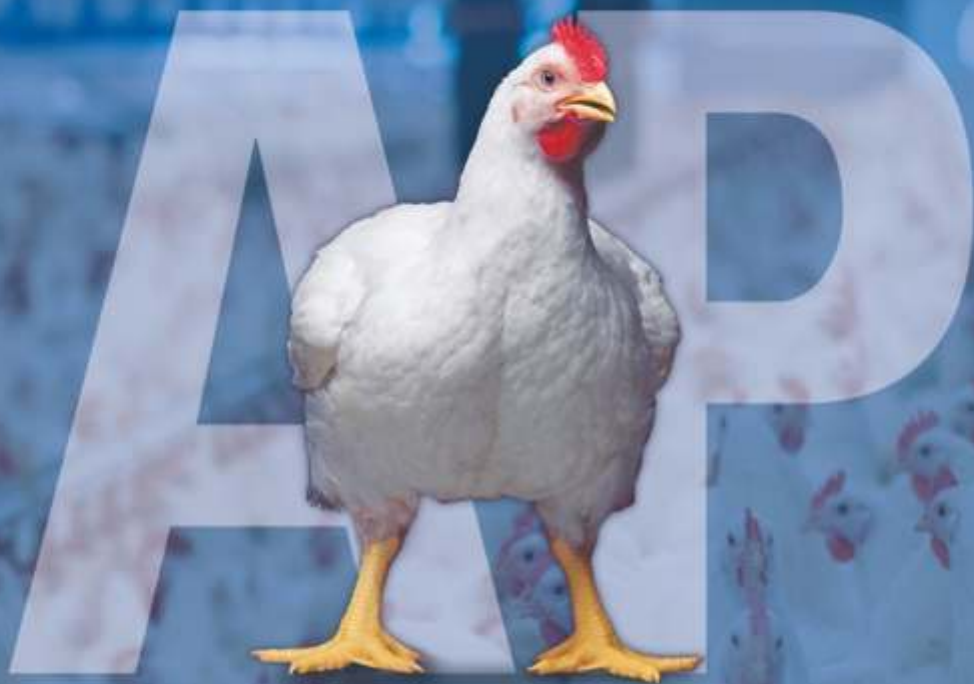
